



The College recognises that senior students may obtain a drivers licence during the year and may wish to drive to and from school. We are also aware that young drivers are inexperienced and are high risk drivers, and that the risk increases with passengers in the car.



In the interests of student safety, the school has the responsibility of managing students on their way to and from school.



- ✓ Students who are legally allowed to drive a car may do so only in accordance with the following provisions:
 - ✓ Students are not permitted to be at their cars during school time (recess/ lunch/spare periods).
 - ✓ Students are not permitted to drive their cars at lunchtimes (lunch passes do not include the right to drive cars).
 - ✓ Students are not permitted to have other students as passengers in their car without written permission (see below).
 - ✓ Complaints from staff and/or members of the public about reckless driving will result in the student no longer being permitted to drive to school.
 - ✓ Cars must be legally parked outside of the school grounds.
- Any breach of the above conditions will result in the student no longer being permitted to drive to school.*



Students may apply for permission to transport a sibling or friend to and from school. The application must be submitted to the Principal in writing and be supported by a letter from the parents of both the driver and the passenger.
